

# DANIEL O'DONNELL AT OPRYLAND-NASHVILLE

Thurs.-Sat., June 24-26

Daniel O'Donnell will be performing at the Grand Ole Opry House on the Opryland complex in Nashville on Thursday evening. Come and experience his trademark combination of country music, inspirational ballads, 1960's pop and Irish standards.

Our lodging will be at the fantastic Gaylord Opryland Resort where you are surrounded by glass-enclosed atriums filled with waterfalls, trees, plants and flowers along winding pathways. It doesn't matter what the weather is like outdoors, the temperature indoors is a constant 72°.

You will have the option of either a traditional room or you can upgrade to a balcony room where the French doors will open up into the glass-enclosed atrium.
