Depart Casino for Gilmore Car Museum

11:15 AM

Arrive at Gilmore Car & Miniature Museum for Lunch at the Blue Moon Diner and tour of museum. *Restored historic barns house over 200 extraordinary vehicles spanning more than 100 years of automotive heritage. This museum is considered one of the **TOP FIVE car museums** in the nation and its exhibits range from a 1899 Locomobile, to the classic Duesenberg or the elusive Tucker '48, and from the Model T to the muscle cars of the 60s and 70s. Also enjoy a re-created 1930s service station, a small town train station, nearly 75 vintage pedal cars, and of North America’s largest displays of automotive hood ornaments and name badges. Next it is on to the Miniature Museum featuring one of the most impressive collections of scale architectural miniatures in the country. Enjoy over three dozen historical miniature rooms that look as though they are awaiting the return of their occupants at the end of the day. Actual crystal, real silver and hand-painted china—all painstakingly created by artisans in 1:12 scale—make each room come alive. The tables and chairs are made of the finest wood and covered with the finest fabrics. Some of the rooms even have miniature light fixtures that brighten the displays. In addition to the homes there are numerous shops and work places to marvel at. They might include a toy store or a dry goods good stocked with row upon row of bolts of cloth or even a machine shop with metal filings on the floor. The attention to detail by the model makes is breathtaking and definitely must be seen to be appreciated.*

Depart Museum for the Michigan’s first State Prison in Jackson, MI.

Take a guided tour of Michigan's first state prison – now Armory Arts Village. *The tours, "From Historic Prison to Artistic Vision," are presented by Judy Gail Krasnow, Armory Arts' resident Storyteller and Author. HEAR the history, plus colorful tales of former inmates. SEE the underground tunnels and solitary cells. ROAM the Art Gallery and meet artists at work in their studios. Visit an apartment, formerly over 30 prison cells! End the visit with a delicious pre-ordered dinner at The Old Prison Gallery.*
