Tour the Culbertson Mansion. *With its hand painted ceilings, carved rosewood staircase, marble fireplaces, and crystal chandeliers, the Culbertson Mansion reflects the affluence of a man once considered the wealthiest in Indiana.*

10:15 AM

Tour the oldest house in New Albany – The Scribner House. *Early in 1813, New Albany began taking shape when the first tree fell to clear the land. The first Scribner cabin was built at East Sixth and Main streets. Later in 1814, Joel built the present Scribner House (now owned by The Daughters of the American Revolution) on the southeast corner of Main and State streets. Immediately, the ground for the new settlement was platted and named New Albany in honor of the capital of the Cribner's home state, New York.*

Depart for B & B Riverboat Thunder Over Louisville Dinner Cruise. *Cruise the river to Louisville, KY where you will enjoy a dinner onboard the boat and the most fantastic fireworks display you have ever seen. Thunder Over Louisville continues to deliver a pyrotechnics spectacular like no other.*
