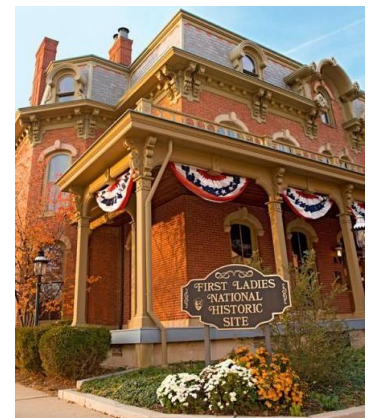
Tuesday, November 6th

11:30 am Departure for Newcomerstown

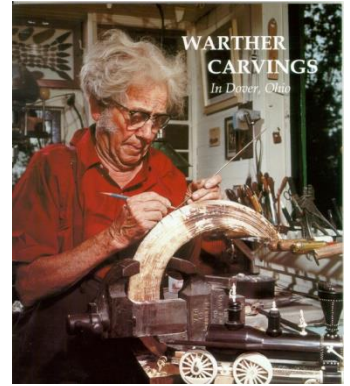
