Sunday, March 31

 Dinner at the Resort. Rest of evening is free

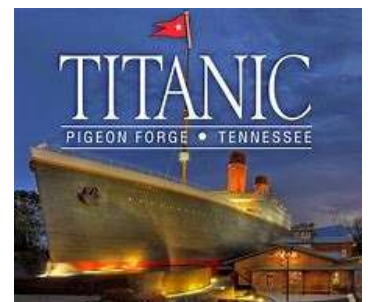
