Hilary Williams is the daughter of Hank Williams, Jr. and granddaughter of Hank Williams, Sr will be joined by Mark Alan Cash, the nephew of Johnny Cash and son of Tommy Cash. You will have a finger-lickin, ' hand-clapping good time at a Southern Fried Gospel Luncheon Show and visit Loretta Lynn's Ranch for another evening with the grandkids of Country Music Royalty! Tayla Lynn is the granddaughter of Loretta Lynn and daughter of Ernest Ray Lynn. She has grown up on the stage and says she started singing as soon as she opened her mouth. She is joined by the grandson of Loretta Lynn's dear friend Conway Twitty. Together they will thrill the crowd with stories about their legendary families and beautiful music. This concert is to be followed by fireworks. On the last day visit the Country Music Hall of Fame in Nashville, TN prior to returning home.

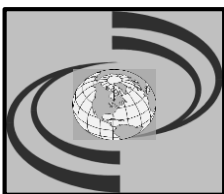
