## Washington DC & Colonial Williamsburg

Sunday – Friday, September 24 – 29, 2023

**There will not be social distancing on the bus – Masks are optional at this time - Requirements subject to change  
This trip will involve longer periods of walking during some attractions and tours**

### Sunday, September 24th

- 7:30 -8:15 am Approximate pickup time depending upon your pickup location. Pickups will be in either Coldwater or Celina, St Marys and Wapak. Exact pickup times will be determined approximately 30 days prior to departure
- 11:30 am Arrive at Mr. Lee's Restaurant in Cambridge OH for buffet lunch and presentation of Many Faces of Old Glory. Acclaimed the "Finest Flag Show in America!" Many Faces of Old Glory tells the history of how we got our flag and how we got the United States. You will see over 20 odd, strange and downright crazy looking flags that tell the paths our flag and our country have taken to become what we see today.

### Monday, September 25th


- 8:00am Breakfast included at the hotel  
Depart for Arlington National Cemetery. Board the tour mobile which will take you through the National Cemetery. It is an impressive sight, with seemingly endless rows of simple white headstones. You will stop at JFK gravesite and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier .
- Late Morning Depart Arlington for U.S. Capitol Visitors Center to meet guide for touring the rest of the day. Sights will include a narrated walk on Capitol Hill with commentary about the Library of Congress, Supreme Court, and the U.S. Capitol Building.
- Lunch Voucher for the Capitol Visitors Center.
- Afternoon Visit White House Visitors Center to gain an understanding of how the White House works and stroll through Lafayette Park for White House photo opportunity.  
Begin the Monument / Memorial tour to include the Washington Monument, The Vietnam Memorial, Korean War Memorial, World II Memorial, Lincoln Memorial, Jefferson Memorial, FDR Memorial, Martin Luther King & Thomas Jefferson Memorial during the next two days.
- Late Afternoon Visit National Harbor for free time and dinner on your own. With views of Woodrow Wilson Bridge over the Potomac River, National Harbor is a convention center hub with everything from busy outlet mall shopping to a casino. The waterfront is home to a vibrant carousel and a unique sculpture, plus a ferry terminal and a marina sporting a Ferris wheel. Enjoy time on your own for shopping and dinner at 40 or more various restaurants choices.

- 8:00 am Depart hotel and meet guide to continue they DC City & Monument Tour. Visit the Pentagon Memorial that honors the 184 lives lost in the Pentagon and on American Airlines Flight 77 during the 9/11 terrorist attacks.

- Afternoon **Visit National Museum of the U.S. Army.** The NEW Museum of the United States Army celebrates over 240 years of Army History and honors our Nation's Soldiers—past, present, and future—The Regular Army, The Army Reserve, and the National Guard. The Museum is the first comprehensive and truly national museum to capture, display and interpret the Army history. The Museum brings to life that history in times of war and peace as told through those on the front lines. The Museum also offers educational experiences illustrating the Army's role in


building and defending our nation, humanitarian missions and technological and medical breakthroughs.  
**Visit George Washington's Mount Vernon** - One of the nation's most beloved historic sites, Tour the Mansion, visit other outbuildings, gardens, Washington's tomb, the slave memorial, a working farm, and more. In the included Education Center you can explore 23 galleries and theaters to learn about George Washington's life and Mount Vernon's enslaved community. See hundreds of artifacts from Washington's lifetime, movies, a 4D theater, and an interactive theater, all included with your admission

- 5:00 pm Check into hotel in Williamsburg area
- 6:00 pm Dinner at a Colonial Williamsburg Tavern included. Enjoy a delicious dinner at one of Colonial Williamsburg Taverns. Everything is true to the time period at the Taverns, from the fashion worn by servers to the pewter candlesticks—all adding to an air of colonial elegance.
- 8:00 pm Depart and return to hotel




**Thursday, September 28**

Visit a trade shop or historic house and discover something about the everyday life of Williamsburg's 18th-century residents. Lunch on your own at Colonial Williamsburg

- 6:00 pm Check into hotel in Lewisburg, WV. Dinner on your own. Rest of evening free

**Friday, September 29**

- Breakfast included at the hotel
- 9:00 am Depart hotel for The Greenbrier Resort in White Sulphur Springs, WV for a tour of the declassified Bunker at The Greenbrier. Built by the Eisenhower Administration. It was a Fall Out Shelter for Congress in the event of a Nuclear Attack. This secret facility existed for 30 years, in plain sight, yet hidden from both hotel employees and guests. It's a fascinating story and you will learn how the pantries were stocked and replenished with fresh produce and supplies. At any moment there was enough fresh water and food here to support the entire House & Senate for 60 days.
- 11:30 am Depart for Tamarack
- 12:45 pm Arrive at Tamarack for Lunch on your own
- 2:30 pm Depart Tamarack
- Dinner stop at Cracker Barrel (\$10 Gift card included)
- 9:00 – 10:00 pm Approximate time to return home depending upon your pickup location.
