Monday, June 22

- 7:00 – 8:00 am Approximate departure time depending upon your pickup location. Pickups will be in Lima, Wapak, St Marys, and either Coldwater or Celina. Exact pickup times and locations will be determined approximately 30 days prior to trip departure

1. Ride on the Maid of the Mist. The oldest and most popular tourist attraction at Niagara Falls takes passengers on a ride past American Falls and into the roaring basin of Horseshoe Falls.
 2. Niagara Adventure Theater. Hold onto your seats for the most powerful and involving film experience the brings reality to life on the big screen. You will witness Niagara Falls' incredible stories and history that would otherwise take a lifetime to experience in just 30 minutes. Discover the thundering Falls from a completely new and exhilarating perspective and plunge over them with history's daredevils.
 3. Cave of the Winds. The Cave of the Winds is the best way to get close to the falls on the American side. It's not actually a cave but stairs that allows you to actually touch Niagara Falls!
 4. Aquarium of Niagara. The aquarium has over 30 exhibits including the new Penguin Coast exhibit, 200 aquatic animal species, and daily penguin, shark and tidal pool feedings.
 5. Niagara Scenic Trolley. The best way to see the Park! Stopping at several locations throughout the park, board and stay on for the entire 3-mile route or get on and off as you wish.
 6. Lunch at The Top of the Falls Restaurant, the only restaurant overlooking Niagara Falls.

Wednesday, June 24

- 9:10 am Depart for Niagara Power Vista Plant
- 9:30 am The Niagara Power Vista highlights the long history of Niagara Falls and the Niagara escarpment being used to create hydro electric power. The two large hydro power plants on both sides of the border are on full display down river from Niagara Falls just before Lewiston, New York. It's where science meets the playground with hands-on interactives, a 4-D ride.
- 11:30 am Depart for Lunch
- 12:00 Lunch and a Tour of New York Beer Project. The all-access tour includes a



little history, science, laughs, and of course, BEER! Guests will enjoy 5 tastes of NYBP beers in a souvenir “can style” logo tasting glass that you can sip during the tour, and an additional fifth 5 oz. sample at the end.

2:15 pm Arrive at Platter’s Chocolate Factory for a guided tour. Guest receive a canvas souvenir tote with samples and coupons

3:15 pm Depart for Herschell Carrousel Factory Museum.

3:30 pm "The Allan Herschell Carrousel Factory achieves significance as one of only two surviving manufacturing complexes associated with the production of carousels during the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. With its architectural integrity intact, the factory is a unique link with this bygone industry, which once provided one of America’s favorite forms of recreation."

5:00 pm Depart for Niagara Culinary Institute.

5:20 pm Take a guided tour through this state of the art culinary and pastry kitchens. This is a journey across 3 floors entering a unique ice lab and a professional kitchen. You will get to taste delicacies along the way. We will be having a sit-down dinner here and following the dinner they will perform a cooking Demo for us.
