Outlaws & Jamboree at Wheeling Island

April 6-8, 2018

Friday, April 6

7:30 -8:30 am

Approximate pickup time depending upon your pickup locations. Pickups will be in Lima, Wapak, St. Marys, and either Celina or Coldwater. Exact pickup times and locations will be determined approximately 30 days prior to trip departure. **ATTENTION LIMA PASSENGERS: You can get on much later and get home much earlier if you get on at Wapakoneta instead of Lima**

12:30 pm

Arrive at Wheeling Island Casino for an afternoon of Dog Races. Receive \$10 food voucher for either your lunch or dinner at the casino. You will check in for a 2 night stay and receive \$25 casino cash each day.

7:00 pm

Depart for an evening's show at The Capitol Music Hall in Wheeling featuring two tributes. The first half is filled with the songs of Johnny Cash and Willie Nelson, who recorded and performed with Waylon Jennings and Kris Kristofferson as "The Highwaymen" in 1985, 1990 and again in 1995. You'll hear such songs as "Highwaymen," "Silver Stallion" and "Desperadoes Waiting for a Train." The second half of the evening is dedicated to the music of Loretta Lynn & Dolly Parton who together with Tammy Wynette in 1993 produced the album "Honky Tonk Angels." They covered such great Country Hits as "Silver Threads and Golden Needles," "It Wasn't God Who Made Honky Tonk Angels," and "Wings of a Dove." Both shows together celebrate the memory of Country Music Legends who performed at The Wheeling Jamboree.

This 3-hour tour is titled with a bit of humor and irony, it features Wheeling's Independence Hall where the vote to secede from Virginia was won in 1863; followed by a tour of WV's gothic-looking prison, that was once on a list of the top 10 most violent correctional facilities.

2:00 pm


Enjoy the Johnny Cash & June Carter Outlaw Prison Concert in the renovated Machine Shop at the Old West Virginia Penitentiary. The song "Folsom Prison Blues" recorded in 1955 was an instant hit and became very popular among inmates who wrote to Johnny. His famous live albums that were recorded at Folsom Prison (1968) and San Quentin (1969) are now classics. What is interesting and much less well-known is that those were two of many, many prison concerts Cash played over the course of almost 30 years. It will feature songs by Johnny Cash such as "I Walk The Line," "The Green, Green Grass of Home," and "Orange Blossom Special" plus duets and accompaniment by his wife June Carter on such songs as "Jackson," and "Ring of Fire."

4:00 pm

The concert is followed by a Costumed Convict & Cop Competition. You are encouraged to get in the spirit of the day and dress as guards or convicts. There will be several prizes awarded by an eccentric Warden who tries to maintain a strict, but happy discipline at the Pen.

5:30 pm

"The Jailbird Feast" dinner with a festive menu of fine food with fun names.



7:00 pm Depart for the 85th Anniversary Wheeling Jamboree Show at Capitol Music Hall. It began in 1933 in the grand tradition of Barn Dance Radio Shows and is still known as “The World’s Original Wheeling Radio Jamboree.” It is one of the last remaining shows of its type, being second only to “Nashville’s Grand Ole Opry” in longevity. This evening’s show is a variety show with the house band, local and regional artists who precede the headliner - country singer and pianist Ronnie Milsap. One of country music’s most popular and influential performers during the 70’s and 80’s, Ronnie became country music’s first successful blind singer, and is one of the most successful and versatile country crossover singers of his time, appealing to both country and pop music markets with hit songs that incorporated pop, R&B, and rock and roll elements. Ronnie is a member of the Country Music Hall of Fame, has received 6 Grammys and had 40 No 1 Hits. His most notable being “Smoky Mountain Rain,” “It was Almost Like a Song” and “(There’s) No Getting Over Me.”


