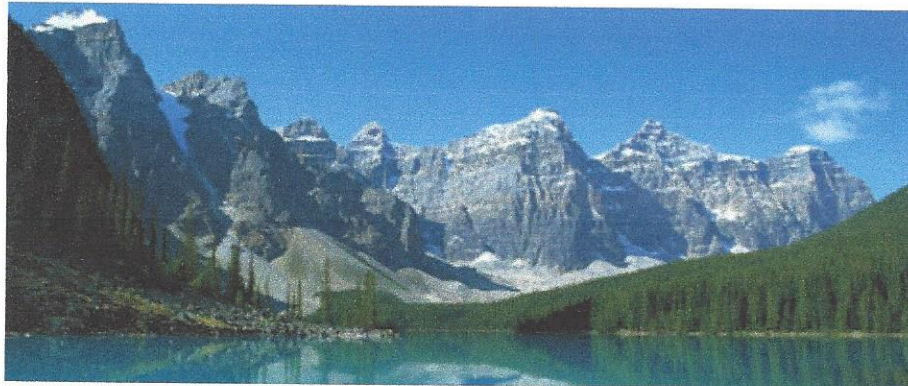

Canadian Rockies, Yellowstone & Glacier National Park Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Calgary

Arrive in **Calgary**, Alberta's cosmopolitan city, meet your **Tour Director** and depart for **Banff National Park** and the charming town of **Banff**. Nestled in the beautiful Bow Valley, the town of Banff's main thoroughfare is cut off at one end by a mountainous rock wall and at the other end by a rock garden. Banff is a year round resort town featuring majestic scenery, a lively Main Street of shops and restaurants and an abundance of outdoor activities including hiking, skiing and golf. Tonight enjoy a **Welcome Dinner** with your fellow travelers.

Meal: (D) Overnight: Banff

Day 2: Banff - Icefields Parkway - Banff

This morning travel north along much of the **Icefields Parkway**, situated between **Lake Louise** and **Lake Jasper**, and considered one of the most scenic highways in the world. See a panorama of snow-capped mountain peaks, hanging glaciers, waterfalls, canyons, and often wildlife such as moose, big-horn sheep and bear. Scale **Bow Pass** with a stop to see turquoise blue **Peyto Lake**. Ride in the specially designed **Ice Explorer** on the 1000 foot-thick **Athabasca Glacier**, part of the Columbia Icefield. Return to Banff for an evening on your own.

Meal: (B) Overnight: Banff

Day 3: Lake Louise & Banff Tour

Today see two of the crown jewels of the Canadian Rockies: **Moraine Lake & Lake Louise**. First stop to view spectacular **Moraine Lake** and the **Valley of the Ten Peaks**. Next stop at the **Chateau Lake Louise** to explore and capture spectacular views and photos of **Lake Louise & Victoria Glacier**. Later enjoy a **Banff Area Tour** including **Mt. Rundle**, **Bow Falls**, **Tunnel Mountain** and the **Hoodoos**. The late afternoon is at leisure to shop or explore Banff on your own. Tonight enjoy the **Oh Canada Eh?! Dinner Show***, a memorable experience featuring a family style meal along with Canadian music and entertainment.

Meal: (B,D) Overnight: Banff

Day 4: Banff - Kootenay National Park - Whitefish, MT

Head through British Columbia along the western slope of the Canadian Rockies, into the heart of Canada's great timberlands and **Kootenay National Park**. See the bright red walls of **Sinclair Canyon** and travel through **Radium Hot Springs**. Then travel across the border to Montana to the town of **Whitefish** for a two night stay.

Meal: (B,D) Overnight: Whitefish, MT

Day 5: Whitefish- Glacier National Park -Whitefish

This morning our destination is **Glacier National Park**, the Crown of the Continent. The excitement begins as you board a **1930's Red Jammer Touring Car** for a ride over the **Going-to-the-Sun Highway**, acclaimed as one of the most beautiful roadways in the world. The 52-mile journey crosses the **Continental Divide** through **Logan Pass** at an elevation of 6,680 feet and includes the **Weeping Wall** and **Birdwoman Falls** along with many spectacular mountain vistas.

Meal: (B) Overnight: Whitefish, MT

Day 6: Whitefish - Yellowstone

Today enjoy the majestic scenery as you travel from Whitefish to **Yellowstone National Park**. The park is home to an astounding array of wildlife such as elk, bear and buffalo. Arrive Yellowstone and check into your hotel. Enjoy dinner with your fellow travelers.

Meals: (B,D) Overnight: Yellowstone Area

Day 7: Yellowstone National Park

Today visit **Yellowstone National Park**, the world's first national park established in 1872. The amazing park features over 10,000 hot springs, thundering waterfalls, geysers and endless forests. Spend much of the day admiring the incredible scenery including **Yellowstone Lake** and keeping an eye out for wildlife. Of course no visit is complete without a stop at the park's most famous feature, **Old Faithful Geyser** that shoots a plume of steam skyward about every 90 minutes. Enjoy time to wander, shop or have a bite to eat in this area around the historic **Old Faithful Inn**.

Meal: (B) Overnight: Yellowstone Area

Day 8: Yellowstone - Grand Teton National Park- Jackson

Today travel south to visit the spectacular **Grand Teton National Park**. Towering more than a mile above the valley of **Jackson Hole**, the **Grand Teton** rises to about 14,000 feet and supports a dozen mountain glaciers. **The Teton Mountain Range** is one of the youngest ranges on the continent. Enjoy a scenic **Jenny Lake Cruise**, the popular lake is located at the base of the **Cathedral group**, the main Teton peaks. During your cruise you will learn about the history, geology, flora and fauna of the area, and have ample photo opportunities. Arrive in **Jackson** where this evening you will enjoy an old west atmosphere at the **Bar J Chuckwagon** featuring a hearty dinner and entertainment.

Meals: (B,D) Overnight: Jackson

Day 9: Jackson - Salt Lake City

This morning travel to **Salt Lake City**. Upon arrival this afternoon in **Salt Lake City**, you will have a panoramic city tour featuring the unique downtown area, **State Capitol**, **Temple Square** and **University of Utah**. Tonight enjoy a **Farewell Dinner** with your fellow travelers at a popular local restaurant.

Insurance benefits are not payable for any loss due to, arising or resulting from: 1. suicide, attempted suicide or any intentionally self-inflicted injury of You, a Traveling Companion, Family Member or Business Partner booked to travel with You, while sane or insane; 2. an act of declared or undeclared war; 3. participating in maneuvers or training exercises of an armed service, except while participating in weekend or summer training for the reserve forces of the United States, including the National Guard; 4. riding or driving in races, or speed or endurance competitions or events; 5. mountaineering (engaging in the sport of scaling mountains generally requiring the use of picks, ropes, or other special equipment); 6. participating as a member of a team in an organized sporting competition; 7. participating in bodily contact sports, skydiving or parachuting, hang gliding or bungee cord jumping; 8. piloting or learning to pilot or acting as a member of the crew of any aircraft; 9. being Intoxicated, or under the influence of any controlled substance unless as administered or prescribed by a Legally Qualified Physician; 10. the commission of or attempt to commit a felony or being engaged in an illegal occupation; 11. normal childbirth or pregnancy (except Complications of Pregnancy) or voluntarily induced abortion; 12. dental treatment (except as coverage is otherwise specifically provided); 13. amounts which exceed the Maximum Benefit Amount for each coverage as shown in the Schedule of Benefits; 14. due to a Pre-Existing Condition, as defined in the Policy. If the event prevents You from reporting the cancellation, the 72-hour notice requirement does not apply; however, You must, if requested, provide proof that said event prevented him or her from reporting the cancellation within the specified period.
