Canadian Rockies, Yellowstone & Glacier National Park Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Calgary

Arrive in Calgary, Alberta's cosmopolitan city, meet your Tour Director and depart for Banff National Park and the charming town of Banff. Nestled in the beautiful Bow Valley, the town of Banff's main thoroughfare is cut off at one end by a mountainous rock wall and at the other end by a rock garden. Banff is a year round resort town featuring majestic scenery, a lively Main Street of shops and restaurants and an abundance of outdoor activities including hiking, skiing and golf. Tonight enjoy a Welcome Dinner with your fellow travelers.

Overnight: Banff Day 2: Banff - Icefields Parkway - Banff

This morning travel north along much of the Icefields Parkway, situated between Lake Louise and Lake Jasper, and considered one of the most scenic highways in the world. See a panorama of snow-capped mountain peaks, hanging glaciers, waterfalls, canyons, and often wildlife such as moose, big-horn sheep and bear. Scale Bow Pass with a stop to see turquoise blue Peyto Lake. Ride in the specially designed Ice Explorer on the 1000 foot-thick Athabasca Glacier, part of the Columbia Icefield. Return to Banff for an evening on your own. Meal: (B) Overnight: Banff

Day 3: Lake Louise & Banff Tour

Today see two of the crown jewels of the Canadian Rockies: Moraine Lake & Lake Louise. First stop to view spectacular Moraine Lake and the Valley of the Ten Peaks. Next stop at the Chateau Lake Louise to explore and capture spectacular views and photos of Lake Louise & Victoria Glacier. Later enjoy a Banff Area Tour including Mt. Rundle, Bow Falls, Tunnel Mountain and the Hoodoos. The late afternoon is at leisure to shop or explore Banff on your own. Tonight enjoy the Oh Canada Eh?! Dinner Show*, a memorable experience featuring a family style meal along with Canadian music and entertainment. Meal: (B,D) Overnight: Banff

Day 4: Banff - Kootenay National Park - Whitefish, MT

Head through British Columbia along the western slope of the Canadian Rockies, into the heart of Canada's great timberlands and Kootenay National Park. See the bright red walls of Sinclair Canyon and travel through Radium Hot Springs. Then travel across the border to Montana to the town of Whitefish for a two night stay.

Meal: (B,D) Overnight: Whitefish, MT Day 5: Whitefish- Glacier National Park –Whitefish

This morning our destination is Glacier National Park, the Crown of the Continent. The excitement begins as you board a 1930's Red Jammer Touring Car for a ride over the Going-to-the- Sun Highway, acclaimed as one of the most beautiful roadways in the world. The 52-mile journey crosses the Continental Divide through Logan Pass at an elevation of 6,680 feet and includes the Weep- 9 Nights Accommodations ing Wall and Birdwoman Falls along with many spectacular mountain vistas. Meal: (B) Overnight: Whitefish, MT

Day 6: Whitefish - Yellowstone

Today enjoy the majestic scenery as you travel from Whitefish to Yellowstone 1 Night - Jackson, WY National Park. The park is home to an astounding array of wildlife such as elk, bear and buffalo. Arrive Yellowstone and check into your hotel. Enjoy dinner with your fellow travelers.

The Teton Mountain Range is one of the youngest ranges on the continent. Enjoy a scenic Jenny Lake Cruise, the popular lake is located at the base of the Cathedral group, the main Teton peaks. During your cruise you will learn about the history, geology, flora and fauna of the area, and have ample photo opportunities. Arrive in Jackson where this evening you will enjoy an old west atmosphere at the Bar J Chuckwagon featuring a hearty dinner and entertainment.

This morning travel to Salt Lake City.
